Description of Skiing Levels

Skiing

Level 1: Beginner

Terrain: Flat Areas. Green. Task: Glide, Wedge & Stop. Lift: Freedom 7

- Introduction to equipment.
- Walk, climb, and glide.
- Gliding wedge- slow down & stop.
- Direction changes to the right and left.
- Introduction and ride the Freedom 7 conveyor, link wedge turns and stop.

Level 2: Beginner

Terrain: Beginner areas. Queens Trail. **Task:** Wedge turns and stop. Introduction to the chairlift. **Lift:** Moonwalk Magic

- Ride the moonwalk magic conveyor, controlled link wedge turns.

Terrain: Blue. Task: Parallel and pole touch. Lift: Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Skis parallel without a wedge.
- Change edges of skis at the same time.
- Can pole swing & touch in all turns.

- Carve medium and long radius turns.
- Short radius turns on steeper terrain speed.

Level 8: Advanced Terrain: All-All conditions. Task: Advanced Parallel Lift Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Making turns more dynamic with good timing & rhythm.
- Use turn shape to increase & decrease speed.
