Despite my understanding of the foregoing risks, I, AGREE NOT TO SUE, TO RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS MCINTYRE SKI SCHOOL, INC., MCINTYRE SKI AREA, LLC, B&B HOLDINGS, LLC AND THE CITY OF MANCHESTER, and their representatives, owners, employees and agents for any damages or injury arising out of participation in my/their chosen Program(s) regardless of the alleged cause, including NEGLIGENCE. In case of malfunction of my ski or snowboard equipment, I authorize McIntyre Ski Shop/School employees to repair as necessary or replace with McIntyre Ski Shop equipment if required, so that I/they may continue participation in my/their chosen Program(s). Description of Skiing Levels

Skiing

If the student has never skied before, please select 0.

Level 1: Beginner

Terrain: Flat Areas. **Green. Task:** Glide, Wedge & Stop. **Lift:** Freedom 7

- Introduction to equipment.
- Walk, climb, and glide.
- Gliding wedge- slow down & stop.
- Direction changes to the right and left.
- Introduction and ride the Freedom 7 conveyor, link wedge turns and stop.

Level 2: Beginner

Terrain: Beginner areas. **Queens Trail. Task:** Wedge turns and stop. Introduction to the chairlift. **Lift:** Moonwalk Magic

- Ride the moonwalk magic conveyor, controlled link wedge turns.
- Make controlled wide & narrow turns, controlled speed.
- Make spontaneous wedge turns and come to a complete stop in both directions at the end of a turn.
- Introduced to the chairlift using the practice chair.
- Understand all safety rules of riding the chair.

Level 3: Beginner

Terrain: Green. **Task:** Wedge christie & speed control. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Reducing wedge turn size & maintaining speed control.
- Developing rhythm while linking skidded wedge turns.
- Control speed by turn shape and wedge size.
- Wedge turns to parallel match wedge christie.
- Match skis parallel in turn to a skidded christie.

Level 4: Beginner/Intermediate

Terrain: Green & Blue. **Task:** Reduction of wedge size open parallel. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone

- Reducing wedge size matching skis parallel earlier in turn.
- Turn shape complete and round. Steering, edging, pressure control & rotary.
- Pole swing touch rhythm and timing in turns.

Level 5: Intermediate

Terrain: Blue. **Task:** Parallel and pole touch. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Skis parallel without a wedge.
- Change edges of skis at the same time.
- Can pole swing & touch in all turns.

Level 6: Intermediate

Terrain: All- Most conditions. **Task:** Dynamic Parallel. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Skidded dynamic parallel turns.
- Steering, edging, pressure control, rotary & balance.
- Linking parallel turns continuously.
- Short radius turns.

Level 7: Intermediate/Advanced

Terrain: All-All conditions. **Task:** Carving. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Carve medium and long radius turns.
- Short radius turns on steeper terrain speed.

Level 8: Advanced Terrain: All-All conditions. **Task:** Advanced Parallel **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Making turns more dynamic with good timing & rhythm.
- Use turn shape to increase & decrease speed.

Description of Snowboarding Levels

Snowboarding

Level 1: Beginner

Terrain: Flat Areas. **Green. Task:** Footed drills. **Lift:** Freedom 7.

- Introduction to equipment.
- Can skate and glide.
- Can walk and climb.
- Can manage (1 foot) J-turns.
- Can manage uphill and downhill edges.

Level 2: Beginner areas. Green. Task: Loading conveyors, traversing & stopping. **Lift:** Freedom 7 & Moonwalk Magic.

- Can safely load and unload conveyors.
- Strap in feet and get up.
- Traverse on uphill edge, stopping with J-turn.
- Slide skid on traverse.
- Traverse with garlands.

Level 3: Beginner

Terrain: Green. **Task:** Turning and riding the chair lifts. **Lift:** Moonwalk Magic & Apollo 14.

- Can turn in both directions.
- Can link turns.
- Can safely load and unload the chairlift.

Level 4: Beginner/Intermediate

Terrain: Green & Blue. **Task:** Speed Control. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Can manage basic linked and skidded turns.
- Working on speed control.
- Working on form and balance.

Level 5: Intermediate

Terrain: Blue. **Task:** Adapting to different terrain & snow conditions. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Can link turns of various shape and duration.
- Can adjust speed on steeper terrain.
- Can adjust stance for changing terrain and snow conditions.

Level 6: Intermediate

Terrain: All- Most conditions. **Task:** Working on the six fundamentals of snowboarding. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Center of mass forward and after center of mass side to side. Pressure, tilt, pivot and twist.
- Working on dynamic riding.
- Can carve turns of various size, shape and duration.

Level 7: Intermediate/Advanced

Terrain: All-All conditions. **Task:** Short radius turns. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Can manage short, skidded turns in the fall line with speed control.
- Can manage short carved turns in the fall line.

Level 8: Advanced

Terrain: All-All conditions. **Task:** Fakie/Switch riding. **Lift:** Apollo 14 & Mercury Redstone.

- Intro to switch riding.
- Can manage all terrain and snow conditions safely and confidently.
